## HARDING COUNTY, NEW MEXICO POLARIS RECOUNT RESULTS 11/23/2021

All 504 ballot images from Harding County, New Mexico were processed by Citizen Adjudicators twice. Because of differences in the adjudications, a total of 40 races on 25 ballots needed a third adjudication.

When we set out to create Polaris, we knew that for each county we would have one of three outcomes:

- 1. The recount would match the reported county totals. In this case, we would know that the count was accurate, and any fraud or errors which occurred in that county happened in a different manner.
- 2. The recount would produce a tiny number of non-matching counts. Although we have a policy that one vote counted incorrectly is too many, this would not point to any serious issues.
- 3. The recount would produce differences which point to a potentially serious issue.

Harding County only had 505 ballots reported by the New Mexico Secretary of State. We were provided with 504 ballot images, so that is already a bit troubling but in line with most counties we have examined. We did not expect to see much in the way of fraud in this small county.

Indeed, the Polaris counts matched the official totals to within a small number of votes. However, digging into the reason for the discrepancies led to a rather disturbing finding.

To demonstrate this finding, we found that in Harding Donald Trump received 316 votes, while Biden received 176. The New Mexico Secretary of State results page

(<u>https://electionresults.sos.state.nm.us/resultsSW.aspx?type=CTYALL&map=CTY&cty=31&name=Harding</u>) lists those numbers as 319 and 179 respectively. While this is a small (about 1%) difference, the total vote count is off by only one (504 for Polaris, 505 for the SoS site. So we set out to find what was causing the vote difference.

What we found is, there are four ballots which do not list a choice for President (one of these had no choices for any race). A fifth ballot lists two choices, and thus the presidential choice for that ballot was discarded. With the SoS reporting one additional vote, that is a difference of six, exactly matching the number of additional votes officially listed for Trump and Biden (3 each).

It follows that the vote scanning/tallying process in Harding County was assigning votes where there was none specified by the voter. This same pattern shows in many other races –"no votes" were somehow counted as votes.

If this anomaly exists in all Dominion Systems, then hundreds or even thousands of falsified votes could exist in larger counties. In addition, it raises the possibility that totally blank ballots could be run through with votes being assigned to them.

Additional Polaris recounts will show if this anomaly is seen in additional counties.
